INTRODUCTION

We last had beef and dairy cattle shown at Egham in 1997, due to the absence of a show in 1998 whilst we re-financed and moved site re-opening in Caddey's Field in 1999 alas without cattle. Over 12 years we have had a small number of cattle exhibited thanks to the help of our good friend from Chertsey Show; Michael Whitty. It was with delight and excitement we announced the running of cattle classes for the first time since 1997 at Egham in 2011 for the Dexter breed to get us on our way. It is hoped this is the starting point of great things to come.

N.B. VERY IMPORTANT NOTE

- The closing date for entries is 22nd August 2018 and must be adhered to.

ADMISSION TO SHOWGROUND

Admission to the showground is on the condition that any person or persons admitted agree and undertake to hold harmless and absolve the promoters and organisers of the show and every other person taking part in or in connection with the management or conduct of the show from all liability for any injury to person or damage to property howsoever caused.

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ: CONDITIONS:

1. All exhibitors must be ready for judging by the time specified for the appropriate class.
2. All exhibitors are required to have their animals on display between 09.00 hrs and 15.00 hrs or to the stewards discretion on the day they attend the show.
3. All animals are the ultimate responsibility of their owner.
4. The Committee reserves the right to vary the schedule if required.
5. All transport licenses required for pigs are their owner's responsibility, movement forms will be inspected and copies collected on arrival and retrospective forms issued on departure.
6. The practice and regulations of DEFRA outlined in the animal gathering show licence and by Trading Standards Animal Health division must be observed as in force on the day of the Show and Bio Security is followed respectively. **TB testing regulations must be adhered to as in force at date of show date as in force for the show area and appropriate for the area your breed is from.**
7. All transport must be parked in designated areas and exhibitor's passes must be carried at all times whilst on the Show Ground. Please ensure your vehicle is clean from any caked on animal waste or mud, vehicles may be inspected on entry and may be required to be cleaned down before entry is granted by a Trading Standards officer. Vehicles must remain in the designated parking area for the duration of your visit. Trailers must be cleaned before coming to the show and must not be used for any other animals between dropping animal at show and taking them away.

8. Disinfectant footbaths and washing facilities will be provided and a changing area will be available. Washing facility will also be available for members of the public. Please ensure all clothing and foot ware worn at the show is free of any excess mud or animal waste.
9. The Bio Security Procedure will be available from the Bio Security officer (James Doran) and his stewards at all times. Additional copies will be placed in the show office and PA caravan.
10. The public will have access to the marquee and judging viewing area. The exhibitors parking area will be closed to public access.
11. The Show Ground is open to exhibitors from 15.00 hrs Friday 23rd August 2019 until 4.00pm on Sunday 25th August 2019.
12. All exhibitors must be on hand during judging of their animals.
13. Exhibitor's passes will be despatched prior to the Show.
14. Please follow the controlled entry route on arrival to the livestock area which takes you round the outside of the perimeter fence to a dedicated livestock gate into the livestock parking and loading area.

SECTION A:

- D1 Dexter Cow or Heifer - dry in calf
- D2 Dexter Heifer - with first calf at foot, can also have calf at foot
- D3 Dexter Cow – in milk
- D4 Dexter maiden Heifer
- D5 Dexter Bull – any age
- D6 Dexter Heifer - in calf

SECTION B:

CHAMPIONSHIP: Selection by the Judge of the overall Supreme Champion and Reserve Champion.

SECTION C:

- D7 Handler class- we welcome all comers to this class (including young handlers)

PRESENTATION OF CHAMPIONSHIP

- A parade will be held at 15.00hrs in the main ring to present these awards.

DEXTER SECTION NOTES & RULES - PLEASE READ:

- Covered pens provided. Pen allocation = 1 x single: = 1 x heifer or cow with calf or 1 – 2 heifer, cow or steer, 1 x bull
- Prizes for each class: D1 – D6: 1st = £30, 2nd = £20, 3rd = £10.
- Prize for class: D7 1st = £15, 2nd = £10, 3rd = £5
- Prizes for Champion = £30, Reserve Champion = £20,
- Rosettes will be awarded in all classes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, and overall - Champion and Reserve Champion. Supreme Champion wins trophy subject to recovery of said item.
- Championship Class Entry = 1st and possibly 2nd place winners from classes D1-D6.
- A simple exhibitor card number system will be used this year, card supplied on the day.

- All classes may be appropriately split or amalgamated subject to all entry numbers.
- Judging will be of a professional standard by qualified judges. It will take place in the judging ring at 10.15 hrs.
- Class times will be advised and called by the stewards using the PA system.
- Lunch 13.00 hrs - 14.00 hrs, or at the Judges / Section Directors discretion but expect judging to have been completed by this time.
- Judge: Mike Kemmish – will judge all classes.
- Chief Stewards: Nicola Doran - ring, Steve Coventry - marquee. Henry Doran – Operations Steward.

Official Dexter Society Spoon & Rosette will be presented by the judge too.
