Competition and Exhibition of Rare and Minority Traditional & Modern Breeds INTRODUCTION

In 1989 we successfully introduced pigs and sheep to the Show as an exhibition. At the following Shows we expanded by holding competitive classes, which have proved very successful. Financial difficulties = no show in 1998 but were back in 1999 until in 2001 & 2007 F & M stopped the show, but we were back with sheep and free entry to celebrate our 150th year in 2008.

Secure covered pens, fresh water will be provided along with the Show's veterinary surgeon should he be required. Free entry to the show ground is guaranteed to exhibitors and competitors. Straw for bedding will be provided too.

N.B. VERY IMPORTANT NOTE

The closing date for entries is 22nd August 2018 and must be adhered to.

ADMISSION TO SHOWGROUND

Admission to the showground is on the condition that any person or persons admitted agree and undertake to hold harmless and absolve the promoters and organisers of the show and every other person taking part in or in connection with the management or conduct of the show from all liability for any injury to person or damage to property howsoever caused.

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ: CONDITIONS:

1. All exhibitors must be ready for judging by the time specified for the appropriate class.
2. All exhibitors are required to have their animals on display between 09.00 hrs. and 15.00 hrs or to the stewards discretion on the day they attend the show.
3. All animals are the ultimate responsibility of their owner.
4. The Committee reserves the right to vary the schedule if required.
5. All transport licenses required for pigs are their owner's responsibility, electronic eAML2 movement forms will be verified
6. The practice and regulations of DEFRA outlined in the animal gathering show licence and by Trading Standards Animal Health division must be observed, as in force on the day of the Show for pigs. This includes ear tags on all piglets of any age and Bio Security is followed respectively.
7. All transport must be parked in designated areas and exhibitor's passes must be carried at all times whilst on the Show Ground. Please ensure your vehicle is clean from any caked on animal waste or mud, vehicles may be inspected on entry and may be required to be cleaned down before entry is granted by a Trading Standards officer. Vehicles must remain in the designated parking area for the duration of your visit. Trailers must be cleaned before coming to the show and must not be used for any other animals between dropping animal at show and taking them away.

8. Disinfectant footbaths and washing facilities will be provided and a changing area will be available. Washing facility will also be available for members of the public. Please ensure all clothing and foot ware worn at the show is free of any excess mud or animal waste.
9. The Bio Security Procedure will be available from the Bio Security officer (James Doran) and his stewards at all times. Additional copies will be placed in the show office and PA caravan.
10. The public will have access to the marquee and judging viewing area. The exhibitors parking area will be closed to public access.
11. The Show Ground is open to exhibitors from 15.00 hrs Friday 23rd August 2019 until 6.00pm on Sunday 25th August 2019.
12. All exhibitors must be on hand during judging of their animals.
13. Exhibitor's passes will be emailed prior to the Show.
14. Please follow the controlled entry route on arrival to the livestock area which takes you round the outside of the perimeter fence to a dedicated livestock gate into the livestock parking and loading area.

- P1 Gilt born after 1st July 2018 (this class will be split if sufficient entries)
- P2 Gilt born after 1st January 2019 (this class will be split if sufficient entries)
- P3 Sow in Pig or farrowed within 6 months of show date - Coloured
- P4 Sow in Pig or farrowed within 6 months of show date - Whites
- P5 Pairs (this class will be split if sufficient entries)
- P6 Sow & litter
- P7 Boar

SECTION B:

CHAMPIONSHIP: Selection by the Judge of the overall Supreme Champion and Reserve Champion. Cup re-presented 15.00hrs during main ring cattle parade.

SECTION C:

P8 Pig Handler class- we welcome all comers to this class (youngster under 18 careful supervision included).

PRESENTATION OF CUPS

- National Westminster Bank Plc., Perpetual Challenge Cup: To be awarded to the exhibitor of the Supreme Champion.
- Challenge cup presented in 1949 to our association for the best pair of porkers and or bacon pig by G. J. Caddey Esq. This cup in the past has been awarded to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth 11. It is now represented for the exhibitor gaining the highest number of points from classes entered in section A.

PIG SECTION NOTES & RULES - PLEASE READ:

- Covered (NEW) pens provided. Pen allocation = 1 x single: = 1 gilt or sow, double pen = sow & litter.
- Prizes for each class: P1 – P8: 1st = £15, 2nd = £10, 3rd = £5.
- Prizes for Champion = £25, Reserve Champion = £15, Exhibitor gaining most points in competition = £25..

- Rosettes will be awarded in all classes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, and for Section - Champion and Reserve Champion and overall - Champion and Reserve Champion. Champion & most points all win trophies.
- Championship Class Entry = Champion and Reserve Champion for each Section Championship class from Section A.
- Points for each class: P1 – P6: 1st = 15, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 5, Section Championships, overall Championship and class P7 and classes held just for fun do not carry points.
- A simple exhibitor card number system will be used this year, card supplied on the day.
- All classes may be appropriately split or amalgamated subject to all entry numbers.
- Judging will be of a professional standard by qualified judges. It will take place in the judging ring at 10.00 hrs.
- Class times will be advised and called by the stewards using the PA system.
- Lunch 13.00 hrs - 14.00 hrs, or at the Judges / Section Directors discretion but expect judging to have been completed by this time.
- Judge: Alice Newth – will judge all classes.
- Chief Stewards: Nicola Doran - ring, Steve Coventry - marquee. Henry Doran – Operations Steward. Special guest - Chris Dent.
- **EXHIBITION:** Exhibitors are welcomed, as detailed below.
- **PIGS:** All traditional & modern breeds welcomed, to form an exhibition on Sunday 26th August 2018, see entry form to confirm.
