It is now represented for the exhibitor gaining the highest number of points from classes entered in section A.

PIG SECTION NOTES - PLEASE READ:

- Covered (NEW) pens provided. Pen allocation = 1 x single: = 1 gilt or sow, double pen = sow & litter.
- Prizes for each class: P1 P9: 1st = £14, 2nd = £10, 3rd = £8.
- Prizes for Champion = £35, Reserve Champion = £25, Exhibitor gaining most points in competition = £30..
- Rosettes will be awarded in all classes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, and for Section Champion and Reserve Champion and overall - Champion and Reserve Champion. Champion & most points all win trophies.
- Championship Class Entry = Champion and Reserve Champion for each Section Championship class from Section A.
- Points for each class: P1 P9: 1st = 14, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, Section Championships, overall Championship and class and classes held just for fun do not carry points.
- All classes may be appropriately split or amalgamated subject to all entry numbers.
- Each exhibitor will be given an individual catalogue number identifying each exhibitor to the stewards recording the class results.
- Judging will be of a professional standard by qualified judges. It will take place in the judging ring at 10.00 hrs.
- Class times will be advised and called by the stewards using the PA system.
- Lunch 13.00 hrs 14.00 hrs, or at the Judges / Section Directors discretion but expect judging to have been completed by this time.
- Judge: Mr Josh Bell-Tye will judge all classes.
- Chief Stewards: Admin: Nicola Doran & Livestock Exhibitors: Steve Coventry, General Operations James Doran.
- Special guest Chris Dent.
- Prize money & entries fees now all online by bank transfer.

ADMISSION TO SHOWGROUND

Admission to the showground is on the condition that any person or persons admitted agree and undertake to hold harmless and absolve the promoters and organisers of the show and every other person taking part in or in connection with the management or conduct of the show from all liability for any injury to person or damage to property howsoever caused.

CONDITIONS

- 1. All exhibitors must be ready for judging by the time specified for the appropriate class. All exhibitors are required to have their animals on display between 09.00 hrs. and 15.00 hrs or to the steward's discretion on the day they attend the show.
- 2. All animals are the ultimate responsibility of their owner.
- 3. The Committee reserves the right to vary the schedule if required.
- 4. All transport licenses required for pigs are their owner's responsibility, electronic eAML2 movement forms will be verified
- 5. The practice and regulations of DEFRA (APHA) outlined in the animal gathering show licence and by Trading Standards Animal Health division must be observed, as in force on the day of the Show for pigs. This includes ear tags on all piglets of any age and Bio Security is followed respectively.
- 6. All transport must be parked in designated areas Please ensure your vehicle is clean from any caked on animal waste or mud, vehicles may be inspected on entry and may be required to be cleaned down before entry is granted. Vehicles must remain in the designated parking area for the duration of your visit. Trailers must be cleaned before coming to the show and must not be used for any other animals between dropping animal at show and taking them away.
- 7. Disinfectant footbaths and washing facilities will be provided and a changing area will be available. Hand washing facility will also be available for members of the public. Please ensure all clothing and foot ware worn at the show is free of any excess mud or animal waste.
- 8. The Bio Security Procedure will be always available from the Bio Security officer (James Doran) and his stewards. Additional copies will be placed in the show office and PA caravan.
- 9. The public will have access to the marquee post judging and judging viewing area. The exhibitors parking area will be closed to public access.
- 10. The Show Ground is open to exhibitors from 15.00 hrs Friday 25th August until 19.00 hrs on Sunday 27th August 2023.
- 11. All exhibitors must be on hand during judging of their animals.
- 12. Vehicle passes will be sent electronically in advance to print at home or report to gate steward on arrival to be directed to livestock area parking and unloading.
- 13. Please follow the controlled entry route on arrival to the livestock area which takes you round the outside of the perimeter fence to a dedicated livestock gate into the livestock parking and loading area.
- 14. All personal data held securely for the sole purpose of this livestock event in accordance to GDPR policy.
